 Is like to lay upon us.

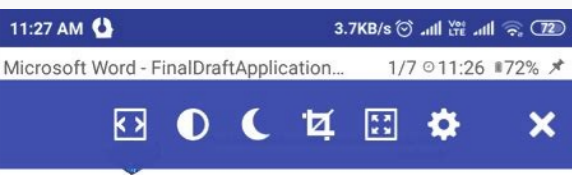
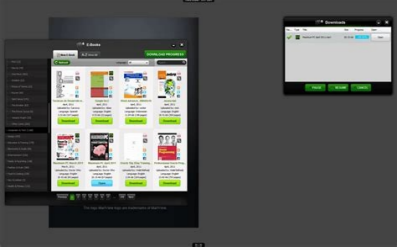
