
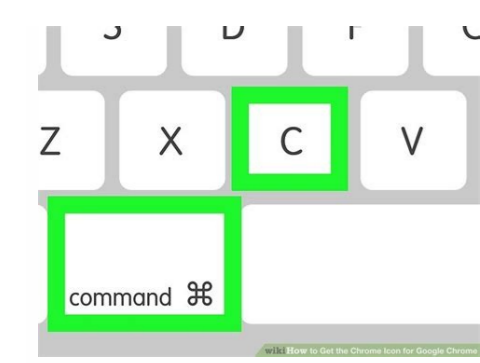

Open the Chrome app on your phone and navigate to the site you want to create the home screen shortcut. Once the site has loaded, open the Chrome settings menu by clicking on the three vertical dots in the upper right corner. Then select add to home screen. A new screen that allows you to automatically insert the icon or choose where to place it. You will see the shortcut icon preview on this "Add to Home Screens" screen. Click the "Add automatically" button to insert the new icon wherever the Android device has free space on the home screen.
