

It was raining when she gave birth. Between 10 to 15 women also die each week due to preventable complications from pregnancy or childbirth, the minister is quoted as saying by the state-owned Zambia Daily Mail. The majority of these stillbirths, maternal and new-born deaths could be avoided through the provision of safe and quality care by skilled health professionals, she said. She called for the adoption of "comprehensive health systems and community-based approaches". The minister made the comments at University Teaching Hospitals (UTH) in the capital, Lusaka, on Tuesday at an event to mark World Patient Safety Day. Ms Masebo was appointed health minister in September, a month after President Hakainde Hichilema won elections promising to tackle corruption and end Zambia's economic crisis. The health ministry has in the past been riddled with accusations of corruption that include the procurement of expired drugs and defective condoms. Since taking up the job, Ms Masebo has said she sees the decentralisation of health provision as a way overcoming these problems and dealing with bureaucracy. During her visit to UTH, she was informed by staff about some of the difficulties they face in providing quality healthcare. She was told that the hospital's children wing currently owed more than three million Zambia kwacha (\$170,000; £126,000) to local firms for drugs supplied in 2019 - a year when the institution only received three of its 12 monthly grants from government. Humphrey Mangisani has been promoted from a lance corporal to a full corporal for his bravery. The story of the birth, which - according to Zambian Reports - took place last week in the eastern Petauke district, captured the nation. Cpl Mangisani said he was called to help the woman who had gone into labour. He organised for a motorbike taxi to take her to hospital and followed behind in another taxi. But her labour progressed so quickly that they had to abandon the bikes and he helped her deliver the baby in a field by the side of the road. "I quickly found a razor blade and helped her to cut the umbilical code. It will also require civil servants to show proof of vaccination in order to be admitted to work, although this will be done in consultation in the country. Health Minister Sylvia Masebo announced a raft of new measures, including a requirement for all visitors coming from high-risk countries to be quarantined for 10 days at their own cost. She also announced heightened surveillance including at border points, markets and in public transport. She said the country was rolling out a nationwide vaccination campaign targeting at least two million people by Christmas day. It comes after police warned and cautioned a journalist from Kenmark Broadcasting Network (KBN) after the privately owned television station aired a story about a presidential aide. In the report the aide is heard telling a top civil servant that a member of the opposition should be "fixed" in an audio clip that has since gone viral. The government has not commented on the story, but advised the media to be "ethical and professional". The civil society consortium suggested the government be more concerned about dealing with the revelations rather than criticising the press. The statement also noted their disappointed that a member of the opposition had been cautioned for using hate speech under the Cyber Security and Cyber Crimes Act, legislation the president criticised while in opposition and promised to repeal. There is increasing scrutiny on Mr Hichilema's government with many Zambians calling for more tangible results.
